SENIOR PREPARATION & FOLLOW-UP SESSIONS



Be Pro Be Proud provides materials for each session that will help students prepare for and follow up after their Draft Day interviews. We strongly encourage schools to use these resources to ensure students are ready for the experience.



SESSION 1: RESUME BUILDING & LINKEDIN

Students learn how to create a resume tailored to their experience—highlighting academics, volunteer work, part-time jobs, and CTE training. They'll also receive guidance on building a LinkedIn profile to begin shaping their professional identity, networking, and showcasing their potential.



SESSION 2: INTERVIEW PREPARATION

This session covers interview preparation, business communication, navigating online applications, and an overview of participating Draft Day companies. Students will learn best practices for professional interviews, effective communication, and how to successfully complete different types of online applications.



SESSION 3: MOCK INTERVIEWS

Students practice in-person, phone, and virtual mock interviews as well as participate in group discussions to reflect on key takeaways. The session empowers students to translate their experiences into career-ready skills, prepare questions for an interviewer, use their resumes effectively, and communicate professionally. 80% of students who attended prep sessions in prior years felt more confident and prepared for their Draft Day interviews.



SESSION 4: POST DRAFT DAY FOLLOW-UP

Seniors will spend time professionally thanking employers they met at Draft Day, responding to offers, applying for roles of interest, and completing a post-event survey to strengthen future Draft Day experiences.

EDUCATOR FAQ



O: HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO ATTEND DRAFT DAY?

A: There is no cost for schools to participate in Draft Day.

O: HOW DO I PARTICIPATE IN DRAFT DAY?

A: There are five key steps to participation:

1. Register your school

2. Recruit students for the Career Expo (open to all high school students)

3. For Interviews, recruit and register Seniors looking for jobs immediately after graduation.

4. Arrange for transportation to and from Draft Day

5. Plan for in-class time for Preparation (3) and Follow-Up Sessions(1)

O: HOW MANY STUDENTS CAN I BRING TO THE EVENT?

A: We welcome you to bring as many students as transportation will allow.

O: HOW MANY STUDENTS SHOULD I BRING TO INTERVIEW?

A. Up 20% of your graduating class (if they are interested in skilled technical careers).

Q: I AM THE POINT OF CONTACT FOR MULTIPLE SCHOOLS - WILL I GET A REGISTRATION LINK FOR EACH?

A: No. You will just need to complete a separate registration form for each school.

O: THE REGISTRATION ASKS IF WE NEED LUNCH. HOW DO I KNOW?

A: If your students will miss their lunch period due to Draft Day attendance or travel time, choose 'yes' on your registration, and Be Pro Be Proud will provide a lunch.

If your students will not miss lunch, will bring a lunch, or if you have plans to purchase lunch for your students, choose 'no' on your registration.

O: WHICH COMPANIES WILL BE AT DRAFT DAY?

A: You can visit our website to see a list of registered companies (updated weekly).

O. CAN SENIORS REGISTER ONSITE FOR INTERVIEWS?

A. Yes! We will have dedicated volunteers to walk on-site registrants through registration as well as a career exploration opportunity before matching them with interviewing companies.

Why Draft Day Matters for Our Students

Preparation & Follow-Up Sessions

To maximize the impact of Draft Day, our students will take part in three pre-event sessions and one post-event session, each focused on a different aspect of career readiness:

- Session 1 | Resume Building & LinkedIn Profile Creation: Students will craft a professional resume and create an online profile to begin their career portfolio
- Session 2 | Interview Skills Preparedness: Students learn practical strategies for presenting themselves with confidence
- Session 3 Mock Interviews: Students practice interviewing in a safe, structured setting and receive feedback to strengthen their skills
- Session 4 | Post-Event Follow-Up: Seniors follow up on interviews by learning how to professionally thank employers, respond to offers, apply for roles of interest, and complete a post-event survey that helps improve future Draft Day events.

By providing transportation and class time for Draft Day and these professional development sessions, we will be able to give our students a complete, guided experience—one that prepares them, connects them with employers, and supports them in taking the next step toward their futures.
